ⓘ Duration: <input checked="" type="radio"/> Yes <input type="radio"/> No Hrs. <input type="text" value="01"/> Mins. <input type="text" value="30"/>	Slide No to Yes to set a duration for the test. Set the hours and minutes by clicking inside the boxes and using the up/down arrows to select the desired time period.
ⓘ Default Time Increment: Mins. <input type="text" value="15"/>	The duration can be increased or decreased by a set number of minutes as needed during the testing session. To change the default setting, click inside the number box and use the up/down arrows to select a new time.
ⓘ Time Window: Start Time: <input type="text" value="07:00 AM"/> <input type="button" value="⌚"/> End Time: <input type="text" value="03:00 PM"/> <input type="button" value="⌚"/>	Sets the beginning and ending times students will be able to access the assessment in the Student Portal. To change the default Start Time and/or End Time, click on the clock icons.
ⓘ Days Window: <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Monday <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Tuesday <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Wednesday <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Thursday <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Friday <input type="checkbox"/> Saturday <input type="checkbox"/> Sunday	Select the days of the week the assessment will be available to students.
<input type="checkbox"/> ⓘ 4 Digit PIN Verification	Sets the requirement of a 4 Digit PIN number students use to take an online assessment in the Student Portal.
<input type="checkbox"/> ⓘ Auto Activation	Scheduled students will be automatically activated to take the assessment online once it is published.
<input type="checkbox"/> ⓘ Auto Reactivation	Once a test is activated, students will be able to re-enter an assessment during the administration window as long as the assessment has not been submitted. The following scenarios will allow the student to re-enter the assessment if auto-reactivation is enabled: student closes/refreshes the browser; the application times out; connection to the Internet was temporarily lost; student clicks the exit button.
<input type="checkbox"/> ⓘ Display Item Details in Student Portal	Allows for the display of assessment details in the Student Portal when reviewing scores. This can be turned on and off at any time in the testing process.
<input type="checkbox"/> ⓘ Display Item Hint to Students in Student Portal	The hint feature is only available for Multiple Choice items created in the Work Space. Upon completion of a test, all MC items that the student has answered incorrectly will be tagged for a second attempt. During the second attempt, a hint for each incorrect item will display and the initial incorrect response will not be available.
<input type="checkbox"/> ⓘ Display Timer	Sets the display of the timer (countdown clock) in the Student Portal.
<input type="checkbox"/> ⓘ Randomize Answer Choices	Sets the randomization of answer choices within each item (if assessment allows).
<input type="checkbox"/> ⓘ Randomize Items	Sets the randomization of test items in online testing (if assessment allows).
<input type="checkbox"/> ⓘ Thermometer	Sets the display of a thermometer that visually shows their score when students submit their assessment in the Student Portal.
Calculator: <input type="checkbox"/> ⓘ Advanced Calculator <input type="checkbox"/> ⓘ Basic Calculator <input type="checkbox"/> ⓘ Scientific Calculator	All three levels of calculators may be selected, however, only one may be opened at a time by students. Tutorials on using each of the calculators can be viewed at http://learn.desmos.com
Equation Editor: <input type="checkbox"/> ⓘ Advanced Equation Editor <input type="checkbox"/> ⓘ Algebra Editor <input type="checkbox"/> ⓘ Algebra with Trigonometry <input type="checkbox"/> ⓘ Elementary Editor	The Equation Editor is part of the CKEditor text box formatting tools. Only one Editor may be selected per assessment. Students use the CKEditor to write the equation in the space provided and click OK to enter it into the text box for scoring. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Advanced Equation Editor</i>: Includes all functions and symbols. For calculus and other advanced math courses. ▪ <i>Algebra Editor</i>: Includes basic elementary and basic algebraic functions. ▪ <i>Algebra with Trigonometry</i>: Includes algebraic functions/symbols appropriate for trigonometry, geometry, and algebra. ▪ <i>Elementary Editor</i>: Includes basic elementary functions for addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division.

<p>Translation:</p> <p>Edit Language Selection Language(s)</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Full Assessment Translation</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Translate Selection</p>	<p>Set the preferred translation language for the Full Assessment (<i>allows student to view entire assessment, including controls and items, in the selected language</i>) or a Selection (<i>allows students to select single or multiple words to translate during online testing</i>). Translation provided by Google Translate.</p>
<input type="checkbox"/> Answer Eliminator	Allows students to cross out/eliminate incorrect answers. Sometimes called the Strike-through tool.
<input type="checkbox"/> Closed Captioning	Enables use of subtitles that transcribe or translate dialog and other interpretive information for videos that have CC available.
<input type="checkbox"/> Color Contrast	Allows student to adjust screen background or font color, based on needs or preference. There are 16 different color choices such as yellow on blue, red on white, white on black, etc.
<input type="checkbox"/> Dictionary <input type="checkbox"/> Picture Dictionary	Allows students to look up words during the testing session. Students can highlight a word and view a dictionary definition and a picture, if available.
<input type="checkbox"/> Graph	Virtual graphing paper that allows students to add points and draw lines.
<input type="checkbox"/> Highlighter	Allows students to highlight text in a passage in yellow, pink, or blue.
<input type="checkbox"/> Line Reader	A moveable, resizable frame to help students track text.
<input type="checkbox"/> Notes	Allows students to click on the talk bubble to make a note to themselves and/or the teacher. The note is moveable and resizable.
<input type="checkbox"/> Periodic Table	A tabular arrangement of the chemical elements, ordered by their atomic number, electron configuration, and recurring chemical properties.
<input type="checkbox"/> Pop-ups	Set in Online Markup, allows students to click on the underlined word or phrase in the text and a Pop-up box will appear with a synonym, definition or other support for that word or phrase.
<input type="checkbox"/> Protractor	A transparent protractor that can move over a question to measure angles in test items. The protractor can also rotate by clicking and dragging on the curved arrow in the circle.
<input type="checkbox"/> Rollovers	Set in Online Markup, allows students to view definitions or other supports for a word, phrase, or sentence. If Text to Speech has been enabled, students may have the Rollover read aloud by clicking on the blue play button.
<input type="checkbox"/> Ruler	A moveable ruler is transparent so students can move it over a question to measure lengths in inches or centimeters. The ruler can be rotated the by clicking and dragging on the curved arrow in the circle.
<input type="checkbox"/> Spell Check	Provides students with spelling and word prediction assistance when responding to Constructed Response or Writing Prompt items.
<input type="checkbox"/> Text to Speech	Text to Speech may be enabled in Online Markup to allow students to hear text read aloud for the passage only, the questions and answers only, or the whole assessment.
<input type="checkbox"/> Text Magnifier <input type="checkbox"/> Zoom	Allows students to enlarge or shrink text.
