New Attendance Policy:

- Washoe County School District has updated the Attendance Policy for the 2024/2025 school year. Absences are only considered EXCUSED when students return to school with a doctor's note. Excused Absences with a doctor's note do not count towards chronic absenteeism. Attendance is very important at Brown Elementary School, and we are trying hard to lower our number of federally chronically absent students. We love it when students are here and learning! District Attendance last year relating to Instructional Minutes:

- Based on analysis from last school year, on average:
 - Non-chronically absent students missed 6.8 school days or 1,900 minutes of instruction during the year
 - By contrast, chronically absent students missed 32.5 school days or 9,000 minutes of instruction during the year
- That is a lot of missed learning that we can never get back. Please try to have your students here at school as much as possible, thank you for your help and support!
