



# C. CARLSON SCHOLARSHIP

## RENO HIGH SCHOOL • RED HOUSE PROJECT

The 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual C. Carlson Scholarship is generously funded by the Carlson Family and named in loving memory of Christina Carlson's mother-in-law, Carole E. Carlson, who passed too young from Hodgkin's Lymphoma, leaving 3 young children.

The C. Carlson Scholarship will award its 3<sup>rd</sup> annual scholarship in the amount of \$3,000 to a graduating Reno High School senior who participated in the CTE Red House Project and passed the End of Program & Leadership Skills Tests. The Reno High School CTE Scholarship Committee will select one recipient based upon the criteria below.

### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

**Demographics** - Any race, ethnicity, gender, who is a U.S. citizen or legal citizen and a graduating senior from **Reno High School** shall be eligible.

**GPA** - The candidate shall maintain at least a **3.5 GPA (unweighted)** and have successfully passed both the **CTE End of Program & Leadership Skills Tests**.

**Qualities** - The ideal candidate should reflect **positive qualities**, such as being a hard-working student, who consistently sets a good example, inspires others, and demonstrates strong leadership qualities.

**Participation** - The candidate shall participate in classes and/or extracurricular activities that **broaden their skills beyond basic academics**, such as work, sports, drama, music, foreign language, community, clubs, volunteering, etc.

**Entry** - Each candidate shall explain themselves and their educational goals, whether it is to attend a university, online university (such as WGU), college, or trade school by **submitting one of the following**: a short essay (max. 750 words) or a 3-minute video presentation, or an online digital portfolio of original work.

**RHS Recommendation** - Each candidate shall provide at least 1 RHS teacher/staff/coach recommendations with their entry form.
