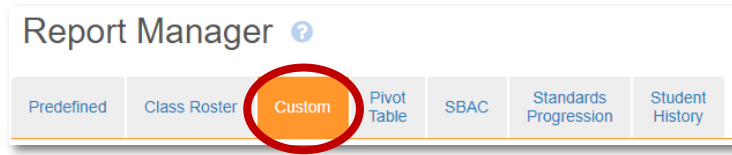


User Generated Reports

► Custom Reports

This report allows for extracting results of multiple assessments within one report. They may be saved for later viewing and shared with others.



1. Click the **Create New** button.
2. To include an assessment in the custom report, click the assessment listed in the **1** “Assessment Search Results” box. It will move to the **2** “Selected Assessments” box and added to the list of selected assessments below. To remove an assessment from the custom report, click the assessment, and it will return to the Assessment Search Results box.

3. As needed, rearrange the order that the assessments will appear in the custom report. To do this, grab the **3** three lines on the left side of the list and move the selection up or down the list order.
4. Click individual checkboxes **4** to include Raw Score and/or Percent Correct data in the custom report.

- Click the  button to view other options that may be added to the custom report. Select options to include in the custom report, as desired.

- Click the  button to view the results of the custom report and to name the report.

- If the report is not displaying information as expected, click the  button to update the selected options.


- Further modify the custom report with options shown below. **Note:** These options are not saved with the report.

Use filtering options to list targeted students. The Filter students' button allows for narrowing the report to selected student groups or grade levels.

Matched Students narrows the report to include only students that have scores for all assessments.

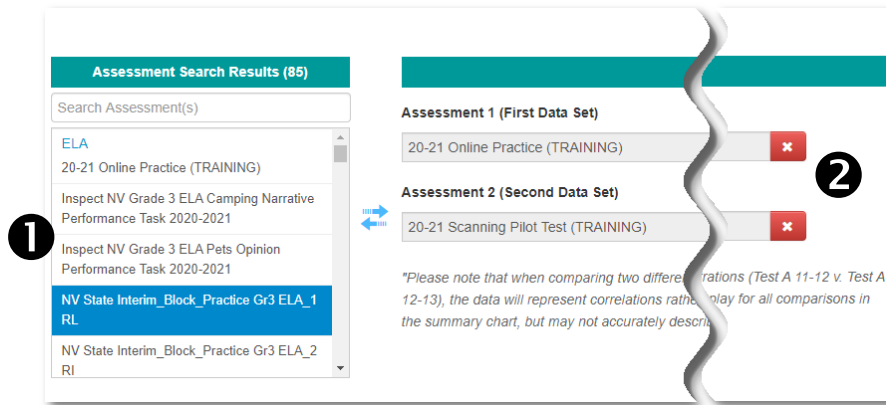

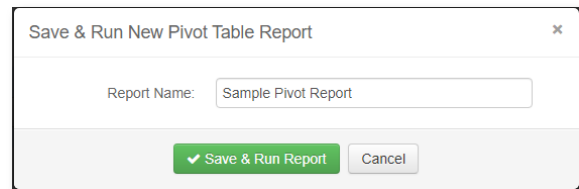
► Pivot Table Report

The Pivot Table report is available when assessments are assigned **performance groups**. This report allows for the comparison of two administrations of an assessment or comparison of two different but like assessments.

1. Click the **Create New** button.
2. From the ❶ “Assessment Search Results” box, select the beginning assessment and then the subsequent assessment. Click the ❷ “X” to remove a selected assessment.



3. Click the **Save & Run Report** button to view the results of the custom report and name the report.



4. If the report is not displaying information as expected, click the **Edit Report** button to update the selected options.
5. Further modify the custom report with options shown below. **Note:** These options are not saved with the report.

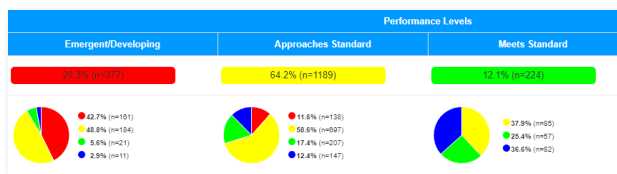
Students are placed in categories based on change in performance from the first to second assessment. Students in the green area improved, yellow maintained the same level, and students in the red did not perform as well.

This view breaks down the results of the first assessment by performance levels which are shown in the first row. The pie graph below displays how the students performed on the second assessment in comparison to the first one.

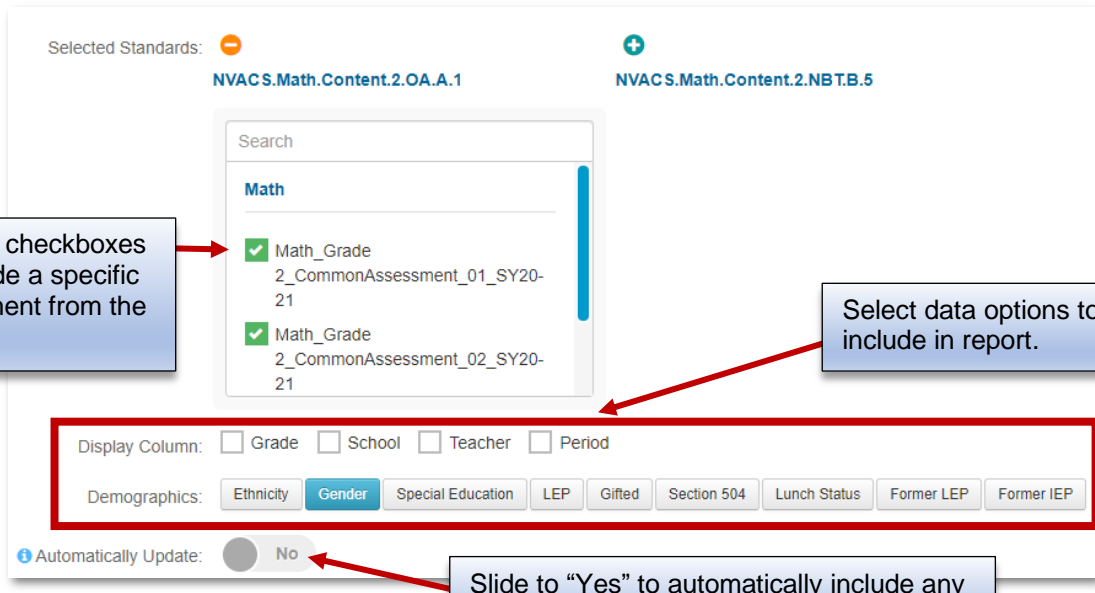

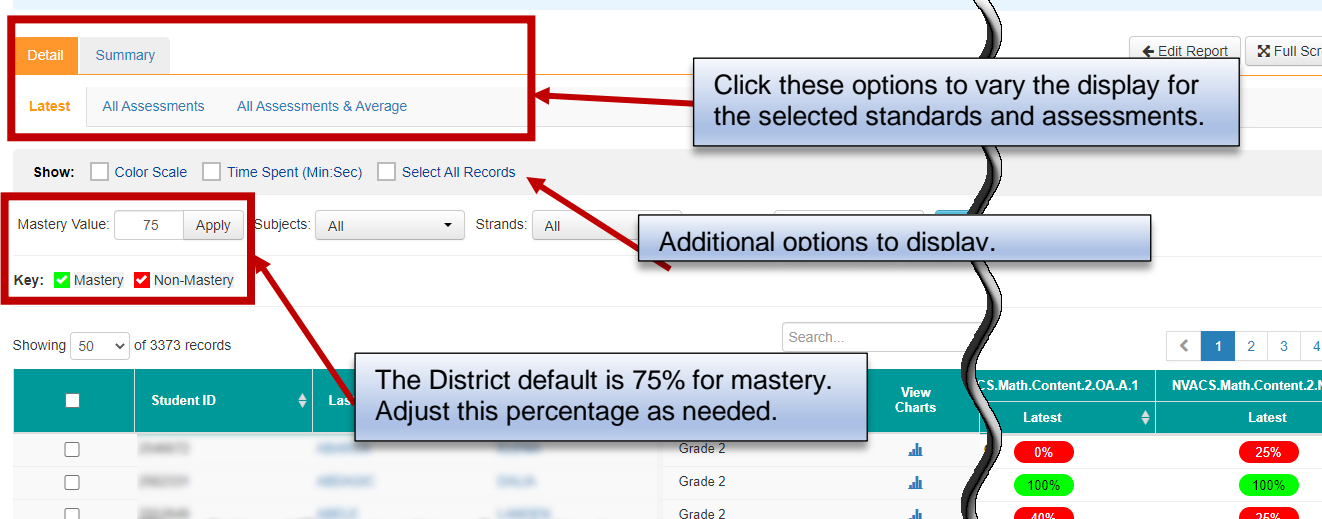
